Sustainability and growth

Since the official launch of GUTz Foundation in the Netherlands in 2014, the main focus of GUTz' projects lies in sustainability and the realization of a strong foundation within the local communities. In line with this and to give GUTz an even stronger Tanzanian backbone, we decided to register GUTz Organisation officially in February 2016 in Dar es Salaam, as a sister-organisation falling under the umbrella of GUTz Foundation Netherlands.

Since then the realisation of festivals and the search for local support and sponsorship became the full responsibility of our strong local, Tanzanian team. So far great result can be seen in the growth in the amount of people tested and the support from local governments, for example the donation of 3500 test kits and 700 second tests within Kahama Region. Furthermore we were able to buy our own tents which we adjusted to be suitable testing units for the rural areas we work in. Since the start of our work in 2013 we have been very thankful for the numerous local partners joining our movement and we are looking forward to work more closely with them again in the future. The media coverage we have had, both by local companies like Kahama FM and national organisations like Clouds, TV1 and Azam TV, will definitely help us to get more and more bigger partners on board, in the business sector as well as in the government and medical field.
